A. John wrote from what he experienced first hand.

1. John 20:30

Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples (I was one of them), which are not recorded in this book

2. John 21:25

Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written.

3. Why John wrote his gospel.

a. John 20:31

But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

A. John 1:1-5

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning.3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.4 In him was life, and that life was the light of men. 5 The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it.

1. What or Who is the Word?

John 1:14

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.

In the beginning was the word, and the word was with God

1. John begins his Gospel with an affirmation of Jesus' preexistence and full deity.

D. John 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

- 1. Misguided forms of the Christian faith stem from getting the answer to the question wrong.
 - a. Jehovah's witnesses teach that Jesus is not God but rather A God.

1. John 1:1 NWT change In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was "A" God.

- b. Mormonism- Jesus is God... but started out as a man
 - 1. Joseph Smith

"And you have got to learn how to be gods yourselves, and to be kings and priests to God, the same as all gods have done before you, namely, by going from one small degree to another, and from a small capacity to a great one; from grace to grace, from exaltation to exaltation..."

2. "As man now is , God once was, as God is now man may be."

c. *Isaiah 43:10*

...Before me no god was formed, nor will there be one after me.

E. John 1:1-2

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning.

1. The Word Is Eternal

F. John 1:3

Through him all things were made;

1. The Word is Creator

G. *Iohn* 1:3b

Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

H. John 1:4

In him was life...

- 1. The Word is Life
- 2. Iohn 10:10

The thief comes only to steal an kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

H. John 1:4b

In him was life, and that life was the light of men.

I. John 1:5

The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood (overcome, extinguish) it.
